Feedback analysis

While responding for Teachers Feedback, 82 % of students the Knowledge base of the teacher is very good. 88 % students opined that Communication Skill (in terms of articulation and comprehensibility) is very good and 12 % students opined that it was good. 86% students stated that the Sincerity/Commitment of the teacher was very good while 14% stetted it good. 70% students know that their Interest generated by the teacher in study but 30 % students opined that it was good. 73 % students opined that Ability to integrate course material with environment / other issues, to provide a broader perspective was very good the teachers are well prepared for class and 27 % stated that it was good. 82% agreed that teachers have Ability to integrate content with other grades while 18% were agreed that it was good. 79% students strongly agreed that Ability of the teacher in and out of the class (includes the availability of the teacher to motivate further study and discussion outside class) they encourage for participation and discussion in class.

92% students agreed that teachers have Ability to design quizzes /test/ assignments examinations and projects to evaluate students understanding of the course. Teachers use teaching aids, handouts, give suitable references, make presentations and conduct seminars. Teachers are accessible in the department and 8 % students agreed that teacher's good ability.78% students believe that they have Provision of sufficient time for feedback. While 94% students were give very good overall performance.

Conclusion- The analysis of the feedback forms received from students, it can be concluded that all the students were satisfied that teachers has punctual, come prepared for class, participate in discussions and are very helpful, completes entire syllabus in time subject knowledge, communicate clearly, , use teaching aids while teaching and satisfied with the evaluation process followed.
