BRIEF REPORT OF WEBINAR

“NATIONAL WEBINAR ON "CRYPTOCURRENCY AND LEGAL CHALLENGES"”

The Post Graduate Teaching department of Law, RTM Nagpur University organized a National Webinar on the topic “**Cryptocurrency And Legal Challenges**” with the objective to know the concept of cryptocurrency and its legal challenges. The webinar was organized on 14th of March, 2022, at 10:00 am to 11:00 am. Through **Cisco WebEx**.

Resource person for the webinar was **Mr. Atul Khadse**, Senior Manager, Legal at L'Oréal, Mumbai.

The webinar started with the opening remark delivered by **Dr. Payal Thaorey HOD and convener** of webinar organizing committee, followed by the welcome address from **Mrs. Padma Chobe**, Assistant Professor, and **co-convener** of the webinar.

Mr. Kullin Bajpayee, Student of the department, introduced the resource person with the audience. Mr. Atul Khadse is an esteemed alumni of the Department during 2002-2003. He also served as visiting faculty in the department. He conducted trainings and workshops on cyber laws. He shared his knowledge on cryptocurrency in this webinar. The brief outline of his session are as follows:

The Hon’ble resource person started the session with explaining the meaning of cryptocurrency. A cryptocurrency (or “crypto”) is a digital currency that can be used to buy goods and services, but uses an online ledger with strong cryptography to secure online transactions. Much of the interest in these unregulated currencies is to trade for profit, with speculators at times driving prices skyward.

He also highlighted the journey of cryptocurrency in India. He throws light on the different types of crptocurrency like Bitcoin, Litecoin (LTC), Ethereum (ETH), Bitcoin Cash (BCH), Ethereum Classic (ETC), Zcash (ZEC) etc.

How does it work? Blockchain technology is used to create most cryptocurrencies. The method transactions are recorded, and time stamped in is described by blockchain. A two-factor authentication method is also required for transactions. To begin a transaction, for example, you may be requested to enter a username and password. You may next be required to input an authentication code sent to your personal cell phone through text message,"

He also explains the remark and view of RBI as a Central Bank of the country, on the cryptocurrency.

Lastly Mr. Khadse remarked that, Crypto assets currently operate in a grey area in India. The absence of regulation creates uncertainty for industry players, opening them up to unforeseen liability with enforcement authorities.

The session ended with a question answers followed by vote of thanks proposed by Mrs. Padma Chobe, co-convener of the webinar.

The webinar was attended by around 150 participants.

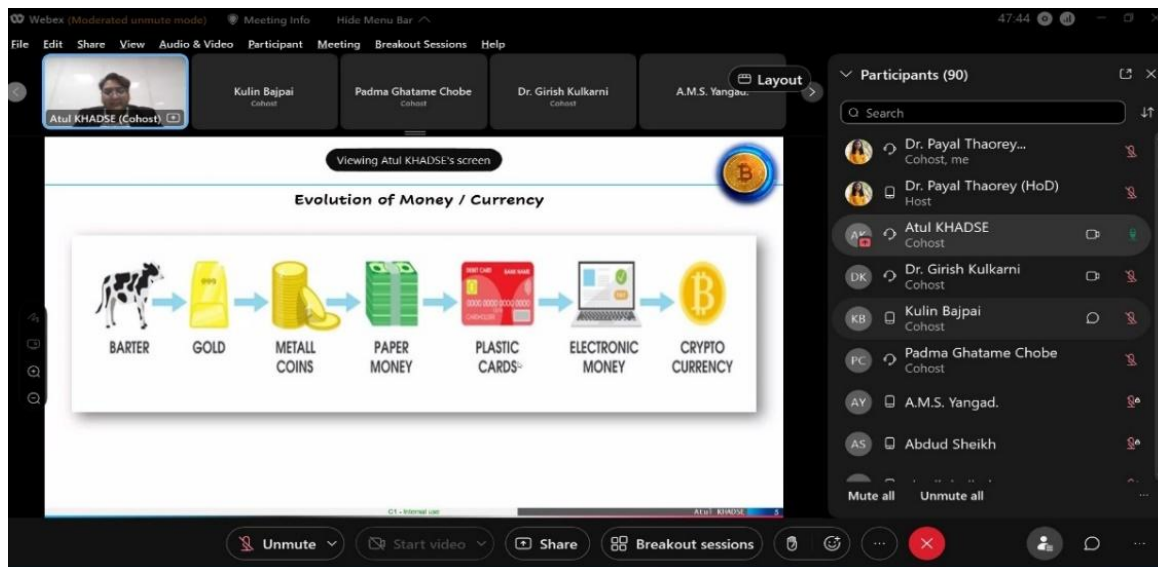
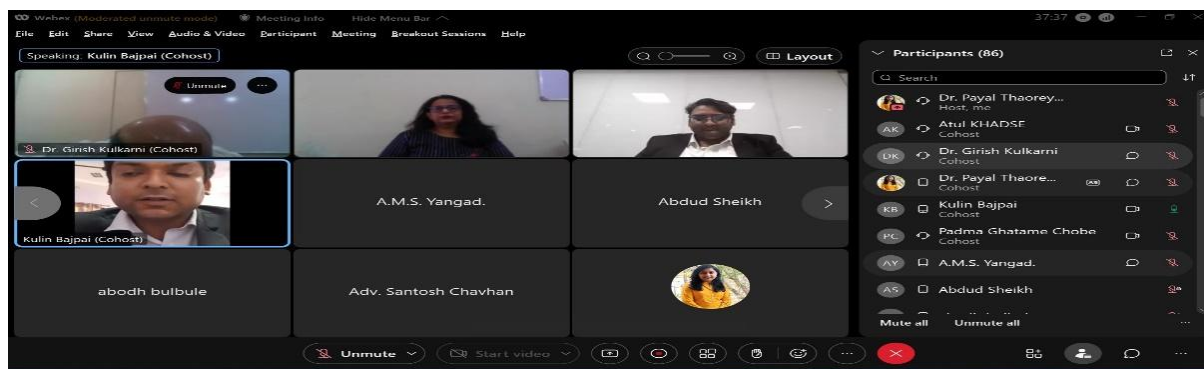

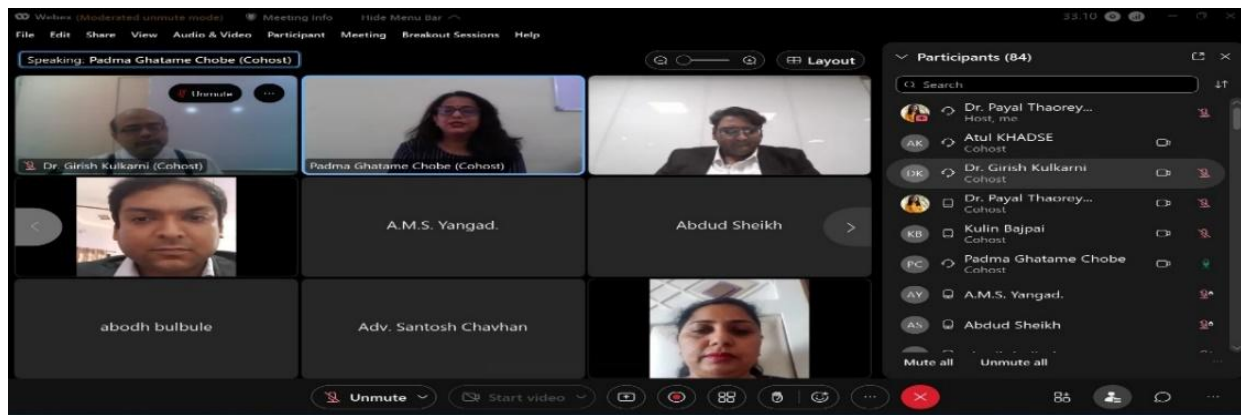
