The Post-Graduate Teaching Department of Law, Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU), Nagpur in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), RTMNU and the Centre for Women's Studies and Development, RTMNU organized an international webinar on “**Human Rights, Global Trends**” on March 19, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. on Cisco-WebEx. The webinar witnessed the gracious presence of Dr. Subhash Chaudhari, Vice-Chancellor, RTMNU as well as the Resource Persons Dr. Sylvia Yazid, Associate Professor and Researcher, Parahyangan Catholic University, Bandung, Indonesia and Dr. Sadiq Syed, Country Programme Manager, United Nations Women, Somalia. The conveners Dr. Smita Acharya, Director, IQAC, RTMNU, Dr. Payal Thaorey, Head and Assistant Professor, PGTDL, RTMNU and Dr. Vijayata Uikey, Director In-charge, Centre for Women's Studies and Development, RTMNU elated the participants in the webinar. The co-convenor Mrs. Dipali Mankar, Assistant Professor, PGTDL, RTMNU laid down the objectives and theme of the webinar. Mr. Ujjwal Wasnik, Student, PGTDL, RTMNU compered the webinar.

The webinar commenced with the Presidential Address of Dr. Subhash Chaudhari, Vice-Chancellor, RTMNU who put some life on sustainability education conjoined with the human rights. Sir emphasized that the human values believe in co-existence with the Mother Nature and so we must preserve and conserve the Nature and its valuable assets. Sir illustrated the vitality of rivers and how important its purity is for the continuance of the human civilization. Sir also explained the human rights must never infringe with the right to existence of trees, birds and animals and the very onus lies on the humans only to guarantee their cohabitation with the humans. Sir also illustrated the duty of every citizen to uphold these obligations. Sir concluded his remarks. The vote of gratitude was conveyed by Mr. Ujjwal Wasnik, Student, PGTDL, RTMNU.

Dr. Smita Acharya, Director, IQAC, RTMNU welcomed the dignitaries present in the webinar and also convened the webinar. Dr. Vijayata Uikey, Director In-charge, Centre for Women's Studies and Development, RTMNU opined the participants of how the Human Rights are pivotal for addressing the contemporary issues.

Later, the Resource Person Dr. Sylvia Yazid, Associate Professor and Researcher, Parahyangan Catholic University, Bandung, Indonesia addressed the webinar. Madam uttered in the webinar of how the norms are a driving force while framing the laws and regulations to govern the society at-large. Madam put forth the concept of 'Evolution of Global-Local Relations on Norm, elaborating on how the theorists have promulgated the postulates which later tend to act at the global level while enacting the laws on Human Rights. Madam illustrated an example of her native country Indonesia where the governance mechanism empowers the local authorities to overlook over the upholding of the basic liberties and freedoms which is the basis of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights as well as the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. The Indonesian Government has established a nationwide campaign called as The National Action for Human Rights (RANHAM) which has been empowered to register as well as report the human rights infringements throughout the country. This campaign has accomplished significant breakthroughs till today. It envisions the protection of the indigenous people as well as sustainable environment in the urban and metropolitan areas. Madam also highlighted the Human Rights City (HRC) Concept under which Rosario, Argentina was selected to be the first HRC in 1997. The Gwangju Declaration on HRC in South Korea in the year of 2011 defined the HRC concept as well as finalized its functions and workings. Madam also put some light on the criteria for forming an HRC at the local level. The objective is to 'Go Local for Global'. Madam also bridged the concepts pertaining to the HRC and the SDGs for which we must root out the gender inequality and workplace bias. To succeed with the HRC, Madam portrayed the chain-link between analysis, improvement, implementation, monitoring as well as evaluation of the Human Rights sustenance under the purview of urban areas. Madam concluded her presentation.

Subsequently, the other Resource Person Dr. Sadiq Syed, Country Programme Manager, United Nations Women, Somalia deduced the importance of gender equality in the twenty-first century-world. Sir exclaimed that most of the Western nations have an equal participation of women as with men in every walk of life but the picture is grim for Africa and Asia. Ignorance of women in economic contribution as well as in workforce makes the

human society to be stricken with under-performance. Women empowerment also alleviates poverty and disparities. The women, demanding equity and not equality, tend to overhaul the patriarchy which tends to picture itself with an unruly behaviour. Sir also made the participants aware with the fact that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the women have been the biggest victims with a colossal damage to their jobs and earnings. The human progress graph tends to be reversing, thus creating huge irreparable losses for them. Sir also called on for the students to encourage the concept of gender equality be in profession, business, decision-makings, etc. Sir also uttered that in today's scenarios, human civilization is at the most challenging turning point in its history. The daunting tasks to uphold international peace and security have been eyeing the very existence of law and order situation globally. The ranging of multilateral wars and climatic catastrophes has changed the course of human progress, posing a serious threat to its continuum. Sir concluded with his remarks that gender-biased society has no reasonableness and it must be made a part of history.

Mr. Ujjwal Wasnik, Student, PGTDL, RTMNU conveyed the vote of thanks to both the Resource Persons and with the announcement by Dr. Payal Thaorey, Head and Assistant Professor, PGTDL, RTMNU the webinar concluded. All the participants applauded the Resource persons for their epitome excellence and in-depth knowledge over the subject. The participants asked the questions enthusiastically which were answered accordingly.

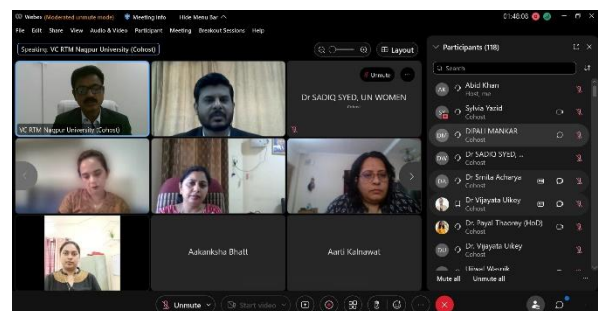
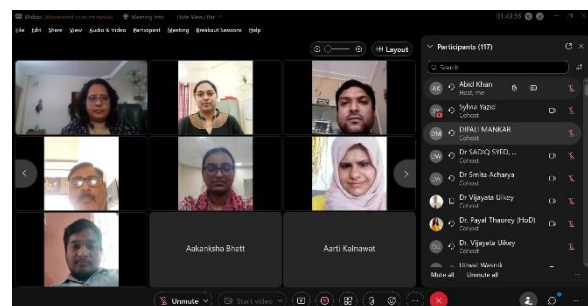
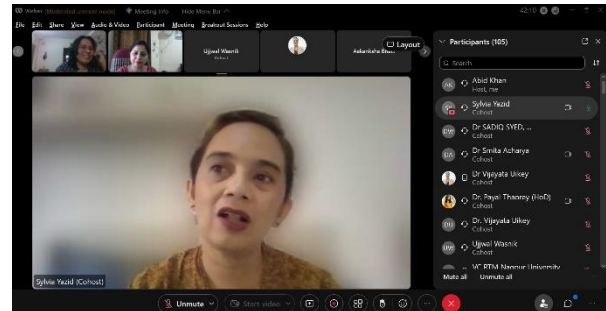
