Rules

MUSIC

1) CLASSICAL VOCAL SOLO (HINDUSTANI /KARNATAKI)

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed
- 2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
- 3. Time allotted for item is not less than 8 minutes and not more than 10 minutes for each style.
- 4. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataka style.
- 5. Cinema songs are not allowed under this item.
- 6. Sufficient thought and care must be exercised in the choice or raga and composition.
- 7. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swar tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

2) CLASSICAL INSTRUMENTAL SOLO (PERCUSSION – TAL VADYA)

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed
- 2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
- 3. Participants must bring their own instruments.
- 4. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataki style.
- 5. Time allotted for item is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 5 minutes for each style.
- 6. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swar tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

3) CLASSICAL INSTRUMENTAL SOLO (NON-PERCUSSION-SWAR VADYA)

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed
- 2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
- 3. Participants must bring their own instruments.
- 4. Instruments of Western origin adopted to the Indian raga system are allowed.
- 5. Item can be presented in either Hindustani or Karnataki style.
- 6. Time allotted for item is not less than 4 minutes and not more than 5 minutes for each style.
- 7. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swar tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.

4) GROUP SONG (INDIAN)

- 1. Only one team per college is allowed
- 2. Two group songs will be presented by the same team out of which one will be a folk song and the other patriotic.
- 3. Maximum number of singers in a group can be 6 Maximum numbers of accompanists playing instruments shall be 3.
- 4. The group songs should be taken from Indian songs which can be of any regional language.
- 5. No film song should be presented as group songs.
- 6. Maximum Time allotted for the group song is 10 minutes which does not included setting time. The setting time for a group shall not exceed 2 minutes.
- 7. Judgments of this item will be on the basis of quality of singing only and not on makeup costumes and action of the team.

5) WESTERN VOCAL SOLO

- 1. Only one entry per College is allowed.
- 2. Time for Stage/ Instruments setting is maximum 2 minutes.
- 3. The number of accompanists would not be more than two.
- 4. Duration of the song shall be between 3 to 4 minutes.
- 5. Language of the song shall only be English.
- 6. Judgment will be made on the qualities like, composition, rhythm, coordination and general impression.

6) LIGHT VOCAL SOLO

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed
- 2. Maximum number of accompanists is two
- 3. Time allotted for item is not less than 2 minutes and not more than 3 minutes for each style.
- 4. Judgments will be based on the qualities like swar tal, selection of raga composition and general impression.
- 5. Only non-filmy songs are allowed.

7) WESTRAN INSTRUMENTAL SOLO

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed.
- 2. Time for Stage/Instruments setting is maximum 2 minutes.
- 3. The number of accompanists would not be more than two.
- 4. Duration of the song shall be between 4 to 5 minutes.
- 5. Participants must bring their own instruments.
- 6. Judgment will be made on the qualities like, composition, rhythm, coordination and general impression.

DANCE

1) FOLK / TRIBAL DANCE (INDIAN)

- 1. Maximum number of accompanists permissible is five.
- 2. The team may consist of all boys all girls or a combination of both of boys.
- 3. The dance can be either primitive or a folk dance (Indian style) but not a classical one or film dance.
- 4. Duration of the dance should not be more than 08 minutes.
- 5. Three copies of a brief note giving the theme and text of the song if any is to be submitted along with the entry form at the time of registration.
- 6. The participating team will be responsible for clearing the stage.
- 7. Judgments will be based on the rhythm, formation, expression, makeup, sets and overall effect.

2) CLASSICAL DANCE (INDIAN)

- 1. Each college can send only one entry.
- 2. The classical dance can be from any of the approved schools of dance such as Kathak, Kathakali Bharat Nattyam, Manipuri, Kuchipudi, Mohiniattam and Odssi, Satriya
- 3. Each participant will be allowed up to 10 minutes including time for preparation, exit etc.
- 4. Judgment will be based basically on the qualities like tal and technique rhythm abhinays of expression, costume, footwork, and general impression etc.
- 5. Maximum three accompanists are permissible.
- 6. No film pure classical Dance is allowed.

3) LAVANI SOLO

- 1. Only one entry per college is allowed
- 2. Maximum number of accompanists is three
- 3. Time allotted for item is not more than 3 minutes
- 4. Judgment will be based basically on the qualities like tal and technique rhythm abhinays of expression, costume, footwork and general impression etc.

LITERARY EVENTS

QUIZ:

- 1. Each college can send a tarn of three persons.
- 2. Only written round.

DEBATE:

- 1. The Topic of debate is "INDIA WILL FINANCIAL SUPERPOWER IN THE CONTEXT OF BUDGET 2023-24"
- 2. Each college can send only one team of two students one for the motion and another against it.
- 3. The contest is open in English, Hindi and Marathi language only.
- 4. Each speaker shall be given Three Minutes.

ELOCUTION:

- The Topic of Elecution is "PRESIDENCY OF G-20 SUMMIT IS SYMBOL OF INDIA'S POWER".
- 2 Each college can send only one entry.
- 3 The contest is open in English, Hindi and Marathi language only.
- 4 Each speaker shall be given Three Minutes.

THEATRE

SKIT

- 1. Only one team per college will be allowed.
- 2. Maximum number of six participants are allowed to participate in the item.
- 3. Maximum time allotted for each team is 10 minutes.
- 4. Use of makeup, drapery and background music is allowed.
- 5. No personal remarks against persons, character assassination etc. is allowed.

MIME

- 1. Only one entry per college will be entertained.
- 2. Maximum number of six participants is allowed to participate in the team.
- 3. Maximum time allotted for each team is 5 minutes.
- 4. Judgment will most likely be based on qualities like idea, creativity of presentation such as make-up, costumes and general impression.

MIMICRY

- 1. Only one entry per college will be entertained.
- 2. Maximum time allotted for each team is 3 minutes.
- 3. Judgment will most likely be based on qualities like idea, voice, creativity of presentation and general impression.

FINE ARTS

ON SPOT PAINTING

- 1. Item will be conducted on the spot and the participants will be requested to do painting on the subject given by the discharges of the competition.
- a. Duration will be not more than one hour.
- b. Size of the painting will be half imperial size drawing paper i.e. 22 inches by 15 inches.
- 2. Painting can be: done in oil water poster or pasted color.
- 3. Candidates will be bringing their material like brushes paper sheets.

COLLAGE:

- 1. Each college will be represented by one participant.
- 2. Item will be conducted on the spot.
- 3. Duration will not be more than one hour.
- 4. Participants are requested to bring their own Sheets, seissors, collage material and other required items.

POSTER MAKING:

- 1. Each College will be represented by one participant
- 2. Item will be conducted on the spot and the participants will be requested to do poster making on the subject given.
- 3. Duration will not be more than one hour.
- 4. Candidates will bring their own material like brushes, colors, sheets etc.

CLAY MODELLING:

- 1. Each college will be represented by one participant
- 2. Item will be conducted on the spot.
- 3. Duration will not be more than one hour.

CARTOONING:

- 1. Each college will be represented by one participant.
- 2. Item will be conducted on the spot on the given subject.
- 3. Duration will not more than one hour.
- 4. Candidates will bring their own material like brushes, colors, sheets etc.

RANGOLI:

- 1. Each college can send only one student.
- 2. The time allotted shall not exceed one hour.
- 3. The participant should bring their required material for Rangoli
